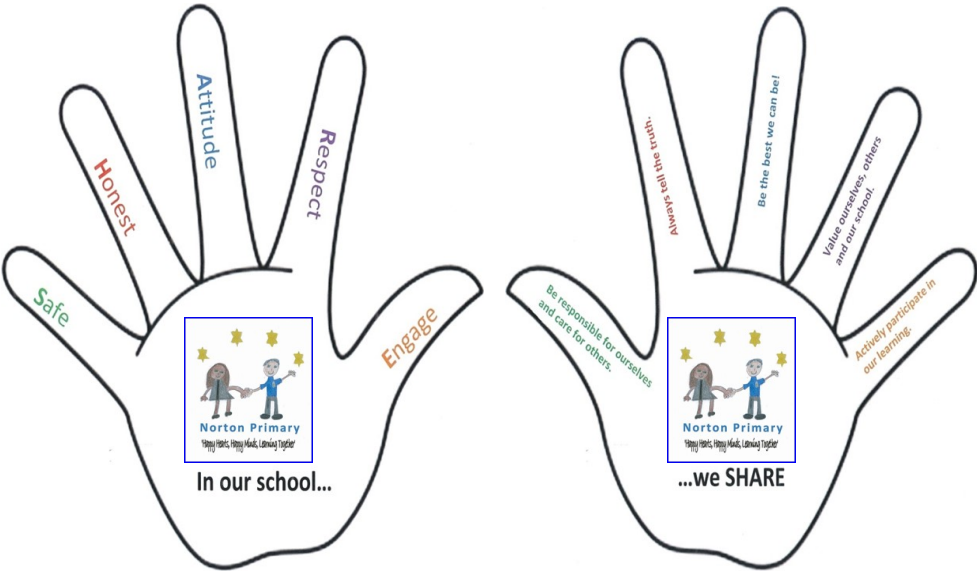




Nursery Newsletter Summer 2017

Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

At school..

We will be settling the children into the nursery setting. We will be looking for good role models of friendly behaviour to help the new children to learn the academy rules.

At home...

Children can practise their listening skills by listening and following instructions.

Physical Development (PD)

At school..

We will be using a range of equipment including scissors, paintbrushes and pencils. We will be moving and travelling in different ways, Throwing, catching and kicking a range of different sized balls

At home...

Children can practise drawing large circle and lines using pencils, chalk and paintbrushes.

Communication and Language (C&L)

At school...

We will be talking about ourselves, our families and describing events and objects we have seen. We will be reading a range of stories and non fiction text for the children to listen to and join in with the repeated parts.

At home...

Children can choose object to bring into school to talk about with the class. Remember to email your pictures to your Childs Key Person.

Literacy

At school..

We will be sharing books, ascribing meaning to marks and writing a range of different things. The children who are going to school in September will be participating in Phase one phonic activities and RWI

At home...

Children can share their reading book, practise the letters in their name and the letters of the week.

Nursery Curriculum

Challenges

All our learning in Nursery is within 7 areas.

Here are a selection of activities and challenges for you to do at home during this term. We would like you to share with us any that you complete!

Understanding of the World

At school..

Through stories we will be looking at a range of cultures and comparing difference places in the world to Norton. We will be planting different seeds in the garden and watch them grow.

At home...

Children can use the internet at home to investigate how we can look after the seeds and to look at different water sources.

Maths

At School...

We will be looking at mathematical vocabulary based around shape, size and ordering. We will be reinforcing number recognition and counting through play.

At home...

Children can look for numbers in the environment as well as patterns and shapes.

Questions...

Who needs water?

What do we use water for?

How can water keep us healthy?

Expressive Arts and Design

At School...

We will be using a range of multi media material. We will be drawing people and other natural objects. We will be exploring different instruments and creating difference dances.

At home...

Children can find different objects around their environment to draw.
