

<p>Summer 1</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The prefix 're' means again or for a second time. Examples: redo, replay, rewrite, rebuild, rearrange, replace, renew, recycle The prefix 'anti' means opposite Examples: antisocial, anticlockwise, antibiotics, antifreeze, antiseptic The prefix 'super' can be added to the beginning of a word to show it is something more powerful or stronger than the original root.
